

RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND INTERNET

Minutes

July 9, 2019

The Resource Conservation and Internet Committee of the Piatt County Board met on Tuesday, July 9, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. in Room 104 of the Courthouse. The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairman Shannon Carroll. Attending were: Carroll, Robert Murrell, Ray Spencer and Keri Nusbaum. Also attending were: Jennifer Harper, Darlene Baker, Eric Seibring, Seth Floyd, Linda Leach, Mike Holmes, Jami Trybom, Scott Porter, Kara Olsen, Jennifer Bryant, EC Gupton and Sheriff Hunt.

Motion: Spencer made motion, seconded by Murrell to approve the minutes of the March 28, 2019 meeting as written. All in favor, and the motion carried.

Carroll said the committee has been reviewing email options. Some versions of Windows will not be supported after January 1, 2020.

EC Gupton explained the differences in the possible changes of email domains. Everyone's email can remain on piattcounty.org and change to Office 365, except sub-domains. If a change is made to piatt.gov emails can be forwarded as well. There was discussion of the options and the costs of each. Spencer and Floyd said it would be beneficial to have everyone on the same platform from a public convenience standpoint. Gupton recommends that the website and email domains match and switch on the same date. The benefits of the G series vs. the E series of Office 365 was discussed. There is a cost savings going with the business (E series). All would need to choose either the G series or the E series, but could choose differing levels.

Gupton will send the different package pricing to Nusbaum and she will send it out to all department heads.
